Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Aaron**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **a-har-one'**

Meaning: The name 'Aaron' is derived from an unknown Egyptian source. It is neither Hebrew nor Greek in origin. Scholars tend to agree on two possible meanings:

- 'Enlightened', 'Illuminated', 'Bright' or 'Light-Giver.' This meaning can easily denote a 'teacher'; one (like a priest) who 'enlightens' others with truth (God's Word).
- 'A High Mountain' or 'Hill.' This meaning can easily denote an 'exalted' person; one high in social status, class or rank. It may actually point to Aaron's position as Israel's high priest.
