Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Abel Maim Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: aw-bale' mah'-yim

Meaning: The name 'Abel Maim' means 'Meadow on the Waters.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Abel' meaning 'grassy meadow' or 'grassy plain.' The second is 'Mayim' meaning 'waters.' It was a city located in northern Palestine belonging to either the tribe of Manasseh or the tribe of Naphtali. 'Abel Maim' is synonymous with 'Abel Beth Maacheh.'

Alternative meanings include: 'Meadow of the Waters.'

Please note: The word 'Maim' is plural in nature (due to the Hebrew suffix 'im').
