Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Abel Mizraim** **Language:** **Hebrew** **Pronunciation:** **aw-bale' mits-rah'-yim**

Meaning: The name 'Abel Mizraim' means 'Mourning of the Egyptians.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Abel' meaning 'breath', 'vapor', 'vanity', 'emptiness', 'lamentation' or 'mourning.' The second root word is 'Mitsrayim' meaning 'Egypt.' It was a place on the eastern side of the Jordan River (in Moab) where the Egyptians (and Israelites) mourned over Jacob's death.

Please note: The word 'Mizraim' is plural in nature (due to the Hebrew suffix 'im').
