Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Abida Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: ab-ee-daw'

Meaning: The name 'Abida' means 'Father of Knowledge.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Ab' meaning 'father'; this basic Hebrew meaning can extend outside the contemporary application of a traditional 'father' to include a 'counsellor', 'judge', 'leader' or 'source.' The second root word is 'Yada' meaning 'knowledge' (obtained by experience).

Alternative meanings include: 'The Father Knows', 'Whom the Father Knows', 'My Father Knows Me', 'Source of Knowledge' or 'Leader of Knowledge.'

Please note: 'Abida' is synonymous with the name 'Abidah.'
