Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Abiel Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: ab-ee-ale'

Meaning: The name 'Abiel' means 'My Father is God.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Ab' meaning 'father'; this basic Hebrew meaning can extend outside the contemporary application of a traditional 'father' to include a 'counsellor', 'judge', 'leader' or 'source.' The second root word is 'El', a word (or name) generally used to denote 'Almighty God as the Creator.'

Alternative meanings include: 'My Source is God' or 'My Leader is God.'

Please note: The Hebrew word 'El' can also denote 'strength' or 'might' in limited circumstances. This is where the term 'Almighty God' came from. Some additional meanings may include: 'Father of Strength', 'Father of Might', 'Source of Strength', 'Source of Might', 'Mighty Leader' or 'Strong Leader.'
