Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Abimael**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **ab-ee-maw-ale'**

Meaning: The name 'Abimael' means 'What a Father is God' (followed by either a question mark or an exclamation point). It is derived from three Hebrew root words. The first is 'Ab' meaning 'father'; this basic Hebrew meaning can extend outside the contemporary application of a traditional 'father' to include a 'counsellor', 'judge', 'leader' or 'source.' The second root word is 'Ma' meaning 'what.' This word is generally used to turn an entire sentence into a question or exclamation. The third root word is 'El', a word (or name) generally used to denote 'Almighty God as the Creator.'

Alternative meanings include: 'A Father is God', 'My Father is God', 'Father of Mael', 'My Father is Mael', 'My Leader is God', 'What a Leader is God', 'My Source is God', or 'What a Source is God.'
