Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Accad**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **ak-kad'**

Meaning: The name 'Accad' means 'To Strengthen.' It is derived from the unused Hebrew root word 'Akkad' meaning 'to strengthen.' This word is generally used to denote a 'castle', 'fortress', 'stronghold' or 'walled city.' 'Akkad' was one of the ancient cities of N. Babylonia. It was originally part of Nimrod's kingdom (Genesis 10:10), and would later become the capital of the Akkadian Empire.
