Bible Name Dictionary

**Bible Name:** **Adamah**

**Language:** **Hebrew**

**Pronunciation:** **ad-aw-maw'**

**Meaning:** The name 'Adamah' means 'Red Earth' or 'Red Soil.' It is derived from the Hebrew root word 'Adam' meaning 'to show blood in the face', a word most often used to denote the color red (the color of blood); and generally has reference to the following words: 'ruddy', 'red', 'rosey', or 'blush.'

The word 'Adamah' generally has reference to 'soil', 'ground', 'land', 'country', 'territory' or 'earth' (from its red-like appearance during the tilling process). The fenced city of 'Adamah' was situated in the territory belonging to the tribe of Naphtali, and probably served as a farming community.

**Alternative meanings include:** 'Earthy.'

**Please note:** 'Adamah' is synonymous with the name 'Adami.'
