Bible Name: **Adithaim**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **ad-ee-thah'-yim**

**Meaning:** The name 'Adithaim' means 'Double Pleasure.' It is derived from the Hebrew root word 'Adan' meaning 'to be soft', 'to be delicate', 'to be dainty', 'to be slender', 'to be pleasant', 'to live in pleasure' or 'to delight self.' The city of 'Adithaim' was situated in the lowlands of the tribe of Judah.

Alternative meanings include: 'Double Ornament', 'Double Finery', 'Double Effeminate', 'Double Dainty', 'Double Delicate', 'Double Luxurious', 'Double Pleasant', 'Double Delightful', 'Double Voluptuous', 'Double Indulgent', 'Double Prey', 'Double Target' or 'Double Booty.'

Please note: The word 'Adithaim' is plural in nature (due to the Hebrew suffix 'im').
