Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Adoram Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: ad-o-rawm'

Meaning: The name 'Adoram' means 'My Lord is Exalted.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Adown' meaning 'to rule.' This word is generally used to denote a sovereign ruler, governor, prince, husband, owner, master or lord. The second root word is 'Ruwm' meaning 'to be high', 'to be lofty', 'to be exalted', 'to be raised' or 'to be uplifted.' It can also denote 'arrogance' and 'pride' in certain circumstances. This usage would generally apply to non-righteous individuals.

Alternative meanings include: 'My King is Exalted', 'My Lord is High', 'Lord of Heights', 'High Lord' 'Exalted Lord', 'High King', 'Exalted King', 'Prideful Lord' or 'Prideful King.'

Please note: 'Adoram' is synonymous with the name 'Adoniram.'
