Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Ahithophel**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **akh-ee-tho'-fel**

Meaning: The name 'Ahithophel' means 'Foolish Brother.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Ach' meaning 'brother', a word that can also have reference to a friend. The second root word is 'Taphel' meaning 'to be tasteless', 'to be unseasoned', 'to be unsavory' or 'to be whitewashed.'

Alternative meanings include: 'My Brother is Foolish' or 'Brother of Foolishness.'
