Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Akeldama

Language: Aramaic

Pronunciation: ak-el-dam-ah'

Meaning: The name 'Akeldama' means 'Field of Blood.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Cheleq' meaning 'portion', 'allotment', 'tract', 'territory' or 'field.' The second root word is 'Dam' meaning 'blood.' The name 'Akeldama' was given to a tract of land (or field) near Jerusalem purchased with the money (30 pieces of silver) Judas Iscariot received for betraying Jesus Christ.

Please note: 'Akeldama' is synonymous with the name 'Aceldama.'
