Bible Name: Alexandria Language: Greek Pronunciation: al-ex-and-reuce'

Meaning: The name 'Alexandria' means 'Of Alexander.' It is derived from two Greek root words. The first is 'Aleko' meaning 'to defend' or 'to help.' The second root word is 'Aner' meaning 'man.' The city of 'Alexandria' was founded by Alexander the Great and was situated along Egypt's northern coastline.

Alternative meanings include: 'From Alexander' or 'Belonging to Alexander.'
