Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Abed-nego

Language: Hebrew

Pronunciation: ab-ade' neg-o'

Meaning: The name 'Abed-nego' is derived from the Babylonian (Chaldean) language. It means 'Servant of Nebo', and comes from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Abad' meaning 'to work', 'to labor', 'to serve', 'to minister' or 'to worship'; it's a word generally used to denote a 'servant' or 'slave.' The second root word is 'Nego' or 'Nebo', the Babylonian god of wisdom and learning.

Alternative meanings include: 'Slave of Nebo', 'Minister of Nebo' or 'Worshipper of Nebo.'
