Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Baal-Hamon Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: bah'-al haw-mone'

Meaning: The name 'Baal-Hamon' means 'Possessor of a Multitude.' It is derived from two Hebrew words. The first is 'Baal' meaning 'to marry', 'to possess', 'to own', 'to rule over' or 'to have dominion.' The second word is 'Hamown' meaning 'multitude', 'crowd', 'tumult', 'uproar', 'noise' or 'abundance.'

Alternative meanings include: 'Lord of a Multitude', 'Possessor of Abundance' or 'Baal of Hamon.'

Please note: The word 'Baal' generally has reference to the following descriptive meanings: 'husband', 'lord', 'master' or 'owner.' It was also used by the Canaanites as a substitute title for their god, Hadad.

On another note... the word 'Hamown' heavily emphasizes unrest, commotion, strong-feeling or noise among a large group of people. It generally has reference to the loud war-cry of troops before a battle.
