Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Baal-Hanan**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **bah'-al khaw-nawn'**

Meaning: The name 'Baal-Hanan' means 'Possessor of Grace.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Baal' meaning 'to marry', 'to possess', 'to own', 'to rule over' or 'to have dominion.' The second root word is 'Chanan' meaning 'to show favor', 'to show grace' or 'to show mercy.'

Alternative meanings include: 'The Lord is Gracious', 'Baal is Gracious' or 'Baal of Hanan.'

Please note: The word 'Baal' generally has reference to the following descriptive meanings: 'husband', 'lord', 'master' or 'owner.' It was also used by the Canaanites as a substitute title for their god, Hadad.

On another note... the word 'Chanan' depicts a heartfelt response by someone who has something to give to one who has a need. Its base root meaning is 'to stoop down in kindness to help an inferior.'
