Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Baal-Meon**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **bah'-al meh-one'**

Meaning: The name 'Baal-Meon' means 'Lord of the Habitation.' It is derived from two Hebrew words. The first is 'Baal' meaning 'to marry', 'to possess', 'to own', 'to rule over' or 'to have dominion.' The second word is 'Maown' meaning 'dwelling-place', 'habitation', 'retreat', 'abode' or 'den.'

Alternative meanings include: 'The Lord's Habitation', 'Baal's Habitation' or 'Baal of Meon.'

Please note: The word 'Baal' generally has reference to the following descriptive meanings: 'husband', 'lord', 'master' or 'owner.' It was also used by the Canaanites as a substitute title for their god, Hadad.

On another note... the word 'Maown' is generally used to depict the ruins of desolate cities now the dwelling-places of wild animals. It can also designate the Lord's dwelling-place (i.e., the Temple).

* 'Baal-Meon' most likely has reference to a Baal Temple. *

*** 'Baal-Meon' is synonymous with the names 'Beth-Meon' and 'Beth-Baal-Meon.' ***
