Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Baaseiah Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: bah-as-ay-yaw'

Meaning: The name 'Baaseiah' means 'Work of Jehovah.' It is derived from two Hebrew root words. The first is 'Asah' meaning 'to make', 'to fashion', 'to accomplish' or 'to perform a work.' The second root word is 'Jah', short for 'Jehovah', the name used to denote the 'Covenant God of Israel.'

Alternative meanings include: 'In the Work of Jehovah' or 'In the Service of Jehovah.'

*** The name 'Baaseiah' can also mean: 'Whom Jehovah has Made.' ***

Please note: The word 'Asah' generally has reference to 'doing' or 'making' something. More specific to our context... this word is used with the sense of ethical obligation especially regarding one's religion.

*** This is especially true regarding the true worship of the Lord. ***

You see... God's covenant people are frequently commanded to 'do' all that God has commanded. This is where the word 'Asah' comes into its primary context. It describes the obedience, work and service involved in keeping one's ethical obligations (especially pertaining to the true worship of the Lord).

Please note: The letters 'iah' in the name 'Baaseiah' are used as an abbreviation for 'Jah' or 'Jehovah.'
